Karlovy Vary · Race day 2 · 30 June



125 Years of gallop in Karlovy Vary

Karlovy Vary is a spa city located about 1.5 hours' drive from Prague. This year, the racecourse in Karlovy Vary celebrates 125 years since horse races have been held in this popular spa town. At the end of June, this spa also hosts one of the most important film festivals in this part of Europe. Traditionally, the race meeting held during the festival is very well attended.

The main race of the second race meeting this year was the second-category race "21. LETNI CENA KLISEN" over a distance of 2.000m for mares aged 4 years and older with a prize fund of around 5.000 euros. **Vignetta (CZE)**, **Pouvoir Absolu (GB)** - **Vesponetta (FR)** 5yo, bred domestically from the Napajedla stud, ridden by **Adam Florian**, dominated. This was the first victory for this mare since winning the Czech Oaks at the same place in 2022. This was also the first victory since she changed trainers at the beginning of this season and moved to Mrs. Pejškova Ivana's stable, which trains at the racecourse in Prague.

El Pago Pago the best in a tough contest

Before the first race (for the Rotmistrz Witold Pilecki Award), **Negro Africa** was withdrawn by the starter's steward, and **Dynamic** quickly fell out of competition (lagged behind). The remaining five were shuffling at the front. Initially, **Anfield** was first, but he jumped the fences veering to the right, soon losing the lead to **One Way Ticket**. After a few hundred meters, all five were practically level. Shortly after, **Et Tu Brute** moved forward, closely watched by **Don Kastors**. **One Way Ticket** began losing contact with the leading four.

About 1000 meters before the finish, **El Pago Pago** started improving his position, soon taking the lead. **Anfield** lost several lengths. After the last jump, **El Pago Pago** was still first, followed by **Et Tu Brute** and **Don Kastors**, waiting to attack on the final straight. However, the gelding ridden by **Petr Tuma** maintained a good pace and was not defeated. Meanwhile, **Anfield** picked up speed, closing in on the rivals. Just before the finish, he overtook **Et Tu Brute** and attacked **Don Kastors** for second place, but without success.

French-bred **El Pago Pago** (owned by P. Borkowska, S. Gornikowska, and G. Mazur) is trained in Wroclaw by **Michal Borkowski**.

Boheme scares her trainer

At the start of the hurdle race for three-year-olds for the General Boleslaw Wieniawa-Dlugoszowski Award, four horses with little experience in this competition lined up, along with four debutants. Nonetheless, the role of favorite fell to **Boheme**, running over hurdles for the first time, in whom trainer **Patryk Wroblewski** and a large ownership group from Rancho Zico stable had great faith.

The beginning of the race, held over a short (for this type of race) distance of 2400 meters, was slow. No one was eager to lead, but eventually, **Galileo Jag** and the spirited **Lips Achat** moved forward. They sped up quite a bit, which resulted in a wide first turn, benefiting **Fast Devil**. **Boheme** stayed behind this group, while the rest of the horses lagged. On one of the hurdles, the rider fell off the gelding **El Capri**.

Entering the final turn, **Galileo Jag**, **Fast Devil**, and **Lips Achat**, who finally calmed under the rider, were in front. The favored **Boheme** was several lengths behind. It seemed she wouldn't be in contention. Meanwhile, Galileo Jag began to lose steam, and Fast Devil and Lips Achat easily passed him.

Boheme started closing in on the leaders. Before the last jump, she was still several lengths behind the leading pair but quickly closed the gap. Coming out of the turn, she joined the leaders and easily overtook them. **Lips Achat** was second, confidently beating **Fast Devil**, with **Galileo Jag** finishing fourth.

As trainer **Patryk Wroblewski** revealed after the race, there was a moment when he had serious doubts whether **Boheme** would manage to join the fight in this race. Ultimately, calmly handled by **Tereza Polesna**, the mare showed considerable potential for hurdle races.

In the race for two-year-olds, nihil novi (Latin: "nothing new"). The victory was taken by a horse trained by **Maciej Jodlowski** - this time the filly **Lady Juliane** (Tamayuz - Maoineas / Teofilo). The race was very interesting despite a modest field (ultimately, 5 horses ran). **Invincible Fairy** lost several lengths at the start, ruining her chances for a good result, as the rest of the fillies galloped very well. **Geia Sou Moro** led into the straight, with the widely galloping **Pani Olga**. **Fargesia** attacked between them, while **Lady Juliane** was boxed in behind them. **Sanzhar Abaev** hoped the rivals would make room for her near the rail, but he miscalculated. Midway through the straight, he decided to pull the filly out wide. The chestnut made a good

impression, as she managed to accelerate in the final stretch and, despite an unfavorable race setup, still won. Just before the finish, she defeated **Fargesia**, who was slightly better than **Pani Olga** and **Geia Sou Moro**.

PALMERA (GER) Impressive Even at Eight Years Old

The ninth race meeting of this year brought a mixed program of flat races, steeplechases, as well as a harness race in sulkies. The racecard did not include races of the highest categories.

The main race of the meeting was the “**REAL PRIM, s.r.o. Anton Mlcuch Memorial**”, a category 2 race over a distance of 1.800m for horses aged 4 years and older with a prize fund of 4.000€. The best was the beautiful grey mare **Palmera (GER)**, aged 8 years. She led the race from start to finish. This was her sixth career victory. According to information from the trainer and owner, this should be the last racing year for the mare, who started her career in the summer at two years old. Her greatest success so far was achieved in Budapest when she won the Lovaregyleti dij (Local Grade 2) over 2,800m in her 3yo season. This time, she was ridden for the first time by the very good jockey from the Czech Republic, **Miss Petra Zedkova**.

The second race of the season for 2yo horses was over a distance of 1.200m, the “**Cena Myjavana**”, with a prize fund

of 2.070€. Only 4 horses started, and the best was the debutant **Odeta (IRE)**, who won the race by $\frac{3}{4}$ length in a fight against horses that had already started.

In the other races, it is worth noting that the trainer based at the Bratislava racecourse, **Marian Stangel**, dominated by winning two flat races and one hurdle race, as well as **Brecka Jaroslav** with one win in both disciplines, continuing his successful season in both flat and hurdle races.

The next race meeting in Bratislava will be on July 14 when the **32nd Slovakian Derby** will be held. In addition to the best 3yo horses from Slovakia and the Czech Republic, the best older horses will also be at the start that day, in races ranging from sprints to long-distance races ranging from sprints to long-distance races.

DIVINA TRIO makes history with 1:13,0 over 2.100m.

On race day in Baden near Vienna, around 4.000 spectators gathered in beautiful weather. The main event on the first race day of the year was the qualifying races for the **Super Trot Cup**.

The star of the day was the exceptional mare **Divina Trio (FR)** 5yo (Nad Al Sheba - Sbirra Trio), owned by Alegra Racing Club and trained in Switzerland (Bern) by Loris Ferro. Divina trotted 1:13,0 over 2.100m, which is the track record in Baden for 2.100m and the Super Trot Cup record in Baden. In the second qualifying race, **Tyron Hill**, a 6yo gelding (Trixtion), triumphed with a time of 1.13,4 over 2.100m, driven by Josef Sparber and trained by Josef Franzl. **Maggiore** finished second, and **Oscarello** finished third.

Loris Ferro celebrated as the catch driver in the French trotters race with **Eckmul Jack** ahead of **Good Fellow** with Mayr, marking his fifth victory of the season. The winner is 10 years old and a son of Kesor de Cossee.

In other races, trainer **Gerhard Mayr** dominated, preparing three winners, two of which he drove himself. Gerhard Mayr, a longtime champion trainer in Austria, opened the season in Baden with the favored **Daria**, a 5yo mare (Tiger Wood As), who trotted 1:14,8 over 1.600m. His second victory of the day was with the 4yo mare **Power Winner** (Booster Winner-Power Metro), trotting 1:16,8 over 2.100m. She will be one of the participants in the Stuten Derby held on 14.07 at the Baden racecourse.

A noteworthy performance was in the last race where the outstanding mare **Sonshine Di**, a 5yo (Orlando Vici), achieved her seventh victory in her tenth start of the season, driven by Michael Shmid - 1:14,8 over 1.600m.

Regarding statistics, it is worth mentioning that **Gerhard Mayr** remains the number one trainer and driver, with **Antonshof** as the number one stable owner.

Among amateurs, **Thomas Royer** is first overall, and 16-year-old **Steffi Mayr** is the leader among women.

The next race days in Austria are on Friday 05.07 in Wels with a monte race and again in Baden on 07.07 with the traditional Ascot!

Zaire Wise As is the winner of the Subotica Mile!

In the traditional and prestigious race "Subotica Mile", the best trotters of Serbia have been competing for years.

This year, the very ambitious owner and breeder from the vicinity of Pancevo, Aleksandar Jankulov, recorded his first victory as an owner. His **Zaire Wise As**, a 9-year-old (Maharajah - Southwind Pamona), triumphed in the race of the day over 1.600m, achieving a time of 1:14. In the sulky was **Dejan Katanic**, and the horse was excellently prepared by Mrs. Saska Horvatski. Second place went to **Amy del Duomo** (1:14,1) with **Vladimir Pribic** from the Jokic stable (Dream Catcher), and third place went to **Igor de Vrie** (1:14,2) with **Stevan Sic** from the Agrostok stable. This was a very interesting race in which the winner was decided in a sharp finish in the last 300m.

Zaire Wise As has a record of 1:11,5 and will also have stallion duties in Serbia.

In other races of the day, the "Mercedes Benz Cup" stood out, where the mare Christi Aguilera AT (Jasmin D Odyssee-Cathrine Sissu) with Milos Kovacevic deservedly celebrated, winning the 2.140m distance with a start from a turn in a time of 1:17.7. The trainer is Bojan Kovacevic, and the Kovacevic family is the owner. They earned 1.100 euros from this victory, meaning that the winners of both main races were from Pancevo.

Second place went to Geronimo SG with Sasa Grujic, and an excellent third place with the older horses was taken by the 4-year-old mare Bonadisea, who will run the derby next month.

The race for horses with earnings of 8.000 euros brought a battle between No Fer ofEm and Corvo Baba. On that very hot Saturday afternoon, the son of Exploit Cafe with Boris Novic in the sulky emerged as the winner from this duel, clocking 1:15.0 over 1.609m ahead of No Fer ofEm with Kecenovc and Rodiva with Dejan Katanic.
