Bratislava · Race day 10 · 14 July



Francis Gold with a Laurel Wreath

In Vendula Koreckova's short training career (she had her first starter on September 4, 2022.), the highest-rated victory so far was a third-category win and top finishes with fillies Niamey and Francis Gold. The latter, representing OZ Roza s.r.o., made her debut in Bratislava at Turf-gala and impressed with a second-place finish in the Arva Prize. An additional entry was made for the Slovak Derby, where she captured the Slovak "blue ribbon" after a fantastic finish.

This year's 32nd Slovak Derby by LESY **SR (Gd-3, 2.400m, 50.000€)** was marked by numerous jockey changes. Some were known in advance: after Saturday's race in Prague, injured David Liska was replaced by Lucie Fialova on MERINO, and in German Mulheim, Josef Bojko, originally set to ride OSBOURN, was to be replaced by Adam Florian. Sadly, the entire race dav was overshadowed by a tragic incident in the Pat's Music Prize, where, after the fatal injury to Palmera ridden by Adam Florian, three more fillies and three jockeys (besides Adam Florian, also Monir Madihi and Petra Zedkova) ended up under medical care. This led to further changes in the Derby: Ferdinand Kraner took the saddle on OSBOURN and Sofie Kvizova replaced Monir Madihi on **HAJEK**.

Martin Srnec, riding one of Zuzana Kubovicova's three horses, NINNA BEST, took control of the Derby, setting a brisk pace. Behind them settled MERINO and BOULEVARD BLANQUI.

For PD Kuty's representative, it looked promising even after turning into the final stretch, with the chestnut still leading at the distance marker. Then came a rocket-like acceleration from **FRANCIS GOLD**, ridden by jockey **Petr Foret** in the second echelon. Although she lost ground on the outer track in the turn, no competitor could match her final speed burst. **FRANCIS GOLD** (at 13.2:1) won easily by 2 ¾ lengths in an excellent time of 2:28,89 minutes. **HAJEK** positively surprised by finishing second, half a length ahead of the bravely battling **NINNA BEST**.

The owner of the winning stable OZ Roza s.r.o. is Frantisek Roza, and his top-stallion daughter **Kodiac** was auctioned at the BBAG spring auction for 32.000€ by Hana Jurankova. Then unnamed, the filly now honors her new name – **Francis Gold**. **Vendula Koreckova** marked her very first victory in the highest category as a trainer, and it was a Derby win. Jockey **Petr Foret** had previously led **Queen of Beaufay** to victory in the Czech Derby 2022.



Victory for Slovak Breeders in the Supporting Races

The unfortunate 31st Pat's Music Prize by TIPSPORT (Category I, 3yo+ fillies, 2.000m, 10.000€) ended in a major surprise when the Loko Trans Slovakia's **ANIKA**, boldly ridden by jockey **Jan Havlik**, won from start to finish. **Anika** is trained in Surany by **Jan Cagan**, who also prepared her dam **Astorka** for a classic victory in the 2017 1.000guineas.

Two victories in Bratislava were also claimed by multi-champion jockey Vaclav Janacek, who did not falter with the favorites. CAPITANO from Loko Trans in the LESY Slovenskej republiky company prize - 31st Mysa Prize (Category I, 1.000m, 7.000€) and MEMENTO MORI from BoKaBau s.r.o. in the LESY Slovenskej republiky company prize - 41st Bratislava Mile (Category I, 10.000€) both 1.600m. met expectations with odds of 1.3:1.

GASPARINI's victory was also anticipated in the LESY Slovenskej

republiky company prize - 31st Golden Cup (Category I, 2.600m, 10.000€). Popular in Bratislava, the TIPPLER Group s.r.o. representative, under his regular partner **Jiri Palik**, decisively defeated his rivals by two lengths.

Loch Swan Undefeated, Marian Stangel's Double to Conclude

The 31st Muscatita Prize (Category III, 1.200m, 3.000€), featuring only three two-year-olds, was a straightforward affair for the unbeatable favorite LOCH SWAN from FeD spol. s.r.o. The final races of the day belonged to Marian Stangel's charges. In the CK DAKA Prize (Category III, 1.600m 3.000€), **WIRRWARR** nearly executed a winning start-to-finish strategy, but was caught by CALAH from Strnisko in the last moment by a head at the finish line. The day's concluding race, the Jozef Kostal Memorial (Category III, 2.000m, 4.000€), turned into a 7-length showcase by ROMINA from 4 starts syndicate. In both cases, the victorious jockey was Italy's Alberto Sanna.

Prague · Race day 7 · 13 July



Cena Latiny won by Quiera, owned and bred by Marek Simak

Saturday's meeting at Chuchle Arena Prague, the only race day at the Czech central racetrack during the holidays, offered the main trial for the Czech oaks - 45. Cena Latiny (Category I, 3yo F, 2.200m, around 5.900€). The result of the race not only provided a view of the current distribution of strength but also serves as an interesting contribution to discussions on the future of Czech breeding.

In the race led by Rabbit Eagles (Wings of Eagles) before River Dawn (Herald The Dawn), who faded in the finish, the Irish-born QUIERA (Decorated Knight) managed to secure victory by 1 1/4 lengths, despite pressure from the sidestepping Napajedla-born Inovace (Egerton), with Jiri Chaloupka in the saddle.

The ward of Ivana Pejskova represents not only the stable of Mr. Marek Simak but also his breeding, despite the Irish suffix. In December 2020, her dam Queens Harbour (Harbour Watch), placed in a pair of German listed races, was purchased for 11.000 guineas at the breeding stock sale in Newmarket via agent Tomas Janda.

Subsequently, the mare, then pregnant by Irish Champion Stakes winner Decorated Knight (Galileo), was sent to Ireland for foaling, where Quiera was born on March 8, 2021. She doesn't meet the conditions to be listed as a Czechbred horse but is undoubtedly a horse of a Czech breeder. This practice, successfully represented by winner Queen of Beaufay (Zarak) from Jiri Travnicek's breeding and this year's Czech 2.000guineas winner San Sebastian (The Grey Gatsby) from Loko Trans, has now seen another firstcategory success.

Double for Masova and Chaloupka

The summer day's program started with another two-year-old race, again very weakly attended, with only four horses participating in the Cena staje Cajdasrot (Category III, 1.200m) after two withdrawals. The favorite role was confirmed by the chestnut filly DS Gaudium WALDERRA (Waldgeist) from Helena Vocaskova's lot, who, under Milan Zatloukal, secured a comfortable two-length victory after her previous

second place. The daughter of twice listed fourth **Shekiba (Arcano)** came to us from last year's Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale, where she was purchased for 10.000 euros.

The winning streak continued with the three-year-old **ASTURIAS** (Siyouni), a brown filly from Mr. Milos Vavra's Bunty Team stable, boasting an excellent pedigree. After triumphing in a third-category race on Derby day, she comfortably dominated the second-category July Handicap over 1.200 meters by 1 3/4 lengths, even with the second-highest weight in the field.

Another consecutive victory, within just a week, was achieved in the Cena spolecnosti KMB Systems (Handicap Category IV, 1.800m) by the six-year-old LATARMISSIE (Pouvoir Absolu - Latarmiss, Scyris) from Jan Sveda's breeding in the colors of the Vega-Horakova stable, once again guided to victory by Martina Havelkova, just like the previous week in Lysa nad Labem.

Czech-bred horses also excelled in other races. Veteran YASANEK (Dux Scholar -Yes Bubba, Shamardal) recorded his fourth career victory in the Cena Hrebcina Menik - Chardonney Tcheque (Category III, 1.400m), part of the Conseq series for Czech-bred horses, after a chasing run behind long-time leader Lowe Wole (Amaron). Another victory in the Cena spolecnosti Tipsport (Handicap Category III, 1.600m) was secured by six-**TOBRUK** vear-old (Shamalgan Tapdance, Lando), bred **Petra** by Bartuschova and serving the BoKa Seniors Team stable.

In the saddle of Tobruk was **Tatana Masova**, who succeeded again in the following Cena Derby Clubu Prague (Handicap Category V, 1.600m) with the lightly weighted **MAIRON** (**Amaron**) from **Gunther Vick's** breeding and stable, achieving the third double of her career.

The sunlit afternoon concluded with the seven-year-old **TRIPLEX** (Elzaam) from the JoVi Zaryby-Novakova stable, whose success in the Cena PP Aset Management (Handicap Category III, 2.600m) gave Josefina Novakova the second victory of her training career. The winner was ridden by **Jirina Andresova**.

36. Stuten Derby in the Arms of Mona Lisa Venus!

If there was any confusion, there is none now!! The daughter of **Light Kronos** and **Xee Venus**, with her driver **Hubert Brandstatter**, is the best filly in Austria of this generation. The derby winner did an excellent job in this race and added another 3.700€ to her account in front of around 2.000 people on a warm Sunday afternoon!

Financial Times. with his driver Franz Konlechner, was leading from the start and dictated a sharp pace. Brandstatter did not want to attack immediately and followed his biggest competitor right behind him. The first 1.000 meters saw no change, with the race pace around 1:16. Then, in the penultimate turn, Hubert Brandstatter pulled out Mona **Lisa Venus** and increased the pace. They trotted side by side until the last 50 meters. where Brandstatter proved stronger in the finish and won by a head ahead of Financial Times, with a time of 1:16.3 over 2.100 meters. the second-best time ever in the Stuten Derby since 2016 and Viva Venus.

The Sunday program marked the return of **Greorg Krenmayr**, the only real competitor to **Gerhard Mayr**, after almost four years of absence. He won with the 4-year-old stallion **Muscle Magic**, followed by **Sonshine Di** and **Highwaytohell**.

In the race of French trotters, **Jarno du Bocage** celebrated with **Julio Zanderigo**over 1.600 meters, ahead of **Good Fellow**.

In the race for horses with earnings up to 28.000€, Eve de Veluwe won ahead of Power Hill and Mayr. Kubes took advantage of Power Hill's poor position and easily led the race to the finish with a time of 1:15,9 over 2.100 meters, the time of Brad de Veluwe's son.

The first race of the day was won by **Iska** on **Line PK** with **Conny Mayr**, who returned to the top 10 professionals with this victory.

The betting turnover amounted to 116.000€.

Tekila Wins the 20th Anniversary Petrovdan Race!

In front of around **1.000 spectators** at the Srbobran racecourse, the traditional Petrovdan race, typically held on the second Sunday of July, took place.

This year, the race was held over a distance of 2.100 meters with a prize fund of 600.000 RSD (approximately 5.100 euros). The winner was **Tekila**, a 6-year-old mare (Euro Staro Crowna - Tulipe d'Abbemont), bred by Dragan Filipovic from Leskovac and owned by **Aleksandar Jankulov** from Pancevo, with **Saska Horvatski** as the trainer.

Saphir AT and Slovenian driver **Joze Sagaj** took the lead at the start of the race, being challenged from the outside by **Igor de Vrie** and **Paladino**.

Paladino took the lead at a strong pace. Tekila and Branko Skenderovic trotted behind Igor de Vrie, who increased the pace after 1.000 meters and took the lead. The pace was sharp, with Saphir and Parma Ferm following along with Tekila and Katemoss. At 400 meters to the finish, Igor trotted on the inside track, with Tekila on the outside. Tekila was stronger and won ahead of Igor. Tekila, as the winner, trotted at 1:16.3 over 2.100 meters. Igor de Vrie finished second, and Parma Ferm came in third!

In the race for horses with earnings up to 5.500 points, **Geronimo SG**, a 6-year-old colt (Fast Photo-Gruccione), won. This beautiful colt, owned and trained by **Grujic Jovan**a, won the race in the final stage, easily overcoming **Aki Boy**, driven by a guest from Sweden, Slovenian driver **Peter Zadel**. Last year's derby runner-up **Irinej**, with **B. Mukic** in the sulky, finished third, showing once again their strong partnership.

One of the most interesting races was the race for horses with earnings up to 1.500 euros, with the main star being **Belina**, a 4-year-old mare (Nesta Effe - Baileys).

The race had an incredible flow - Belina jumped at the start and fell behind the group by about 50 meters, which Samuraj LK and driver Karan used to take the lead. Up to 600 meters before the finish, there was no change in the leading position. From that moment, the best Serbian driver of all time. Brana Mukic, came from behind, driving on the outside, and Belina easily took the track and set a fierce pace. In the final straight. she made а significant difference and won with about 40 meters ahead of Concordia and Dejan Katanic, as well as Valter with Vujkovic **Lamic**, who was likely the surprise of the race, possibly even the day. Belina trotted at 1:18,3 over 2.100 meters, highlighting her candidacy for a high placement in the Serbian Derby, which takes place on August 11 in Sombor. As the derby approaches, it is evident that she is stabilizing her form and entering the right rhythm.

Another future derby participant easily won the race. In the race for horses with earnings up to 2.500 euros, **Not So Fast**, a 4-year-old colt (Infitif - No Angel), won with his trainer **Bojan Marjanovic**, who was also in the sulky over 2.100 meters.

The winning time was 1:19,6. Other placers were **Sinatra AT** and **Athena**. At no point during the race did it seem that young Marjanovic had any competition; he led and finished the race easily and without error, celebrating and bringing another player into the derby match 24!

It is also worth mentioning that one of the guests, Slovenian **Peter Zadel**, who has been working in Sweden for years under the well-known trainer **Bjorn Gopp**, also recorded a victory.

Among the international drivers, **Joze Sagaj**, the best Slovenian driver, and last year's Hungarian derby winner **Emil Csordas** participated in the races. Next week, the trotting caravan moves to Despotovo!

Tekila, the Jewel of Serbian Breeding in the 21st Century

This beauty was foaled in **Leskovac** six years ago. Her pedigree is Euro Staro Crowna - Tulipe d'Abbemont. She entered the life of her current owner Aleksandar Jankulov in 2020, a year marked by many hardships: Covid, lockdowns, and numerous difficulties. She went to **Belgrade** to the racecourse Careva Cuprija, where she near celebrated with trainer Miodrag Pantic in the championship for 3-year-olds held in Zobnatica. In her debut season, she achieved 5 wins and 2 placements. Besides winning the 3-vear-old championship, she also triumphed in 3-year-old Criterium at the racecourse in Pancevo.

After **Miodrag Pantic Misko** went to France, Ema Uncevic worked with Tekila in Pancevo over the winter. At the start of the derby season, Tekila went to Palic

with Brana Mukic, where she won the derby. After a doping control, she was disqualified from the Derby race. The owners filed appeal an to Constitutional Court, where the lawsuit is still ongoing. Due to this penalty, she did not race in the derby rematch. After that, she went to Hungary for a short time with Varga Sandor and then to trainer **Antun Horvatski** for preparations for the 5-year-old championship. Her return to Serbia was crowned with a victory in the 5-year-old championship, and a month after that race, she celebrated in the first edition of the Mercedes Benz Cup (the race with the largest prize fund in Serbian breed horse racing) with Branko Skenderovic in the sulky. Last season, she placed in several more races.

This year, she achieved her record time of 1:15,6 over a distance of 1.600 meters in Srbobran. In Subotica, she recorded a time of 1:16,0 over a distance of 2.100 meters.
