Slovakian Yukatan Successful Even in Czech Colors

Seven different jockeys, trainers, and stables claimed victories on the twelfth race day of the 2024 season in Bratislava. In the main event, the Jiri Novak Memorial at 2.400 meters, the Slovak-bred YUKATAN, trained in the Czech Republic by Jan Havlicek and ridden by Martina Havelkova, emerged victorious.

YUKATAN is the product of the attractive pairing of the stallion Eagle Top (who sired, among others, Derby winner **Gasparini**) and the Slovak titleholder "Horse of the Year 2011" Yucca. During six seasons on the track. Yucca. racing for Autoopravovna Strnisko, competed in 43 races, winning 10 (8 of them at the first and higher category levels, with a top rating of 81,5 kg) and earning 62.437€. Her son YUKATAN initially represented native stable and notably finished fifth in the classic Velka jarni cena. In the current season, now racing for the Czech stable MARPET HK Trans s.r.o., he secured his first victory in the Slusovice IV category and was considered a slight favorite in the five-horse field of the Jiri Novak Memorial (Category II, 2.400m, 4.000€).

The race, run at a slow pace, was led by the pair of "unbalanced" horses with the lowest handicaps, N'OUBLIE PAS and TEN DREAMS. In the sprint finish, it seemed like PERSISTENCEOFMEMORY would win, with BELLARY pressing close, but ultimately, YUKATAN, guided by jockey Martina Havelkova, delivered the strongest finish.

Zamach with the Best Progress

The race day started with two-year-old horses in the Lady Atlanta Prize (Category IV, 1.400m, 2.300€). Half of the eight-horse field were debutants, and among the more experienced horses, **DAEMON** was the favorite (odds 1,6). In his debut six weeks ago in Bratislava, he finished third, a head ahead of today's competitor ZAMACH. This time, however, the tables turned, and the Polish-trained ZAMACH, under jockey Milan Zatloukal, triumphed from start to finish by 1 1/4 lengths. DAEMON (BORMANN stable), ridden by jockey Jaroslav Linek, defended second place in a very close finish among four horses.



Victorious Returns

ADRIANO, representing the MPL Racing stable, was one of the top three-yearolds in Slovak training in the 2021 season, finishing third in the classic Velka jarni cena and second in the Bratislava Mile on Derby Day. His progress was hampered by health issues, and he even missed the entire 2023 season. In the current season, under the care of Jaroslav Brecka, after three average performances, he claimed a victory in the Vosy Handicap (Category 2.300€). IV. 1.400m. winning comfortably by 3/4 length under Dominika Baranova, pleasing bettors with odds of 20.1.

Another recovering horse, **BLACK PAWS** from the Czech Roza stable, also revisited his winning days in Bratislava. Purchased last June in a claiming race in Chantilly for 15.900€ (with a French record of 8 starts, 2 wins, 29.600€ earnings, and a rating of 37 kg), he struggled on Czech tracks and took a break since early September. After ten months, he started in the Hviezdara Prize (Category III, 1.800m, 3.000€) and left his four competitors with no chance, winning easily by 2 lengths under jockey **Petr Foret**.

After more than a year, Strnisko stable's WELSHTINO also enjoyed a victory. His stablemate SANDY ROSE had already scored two wins this season, and in the Boschka Prize (Category III, 1.000m, 3.000€), she was the favorite. Under jockey Jiri Palik, she set a selective pace from the start, but ran out of steam in the end, and WELSHTINO, with a rocket speed from the fourth position, secured the win in a quality time of 58,92 seconds under jockey Monir Madihi.

An even longer winning drought was ended by the stable duo **SPARTICO** and rider **Michaela Jakabova**. Representing Stanislav Jakab's family stable, they competed in their 20th consecutive race.

Their first victory was on July 31, 2022, and the second now, after two years. In the Move Your Vision Handicap (Category V, 2.000m, 1.800€), they moved from last place with a powerful acceleration around the final turn, and despite losing ground, **SPARTICO**, ridden only by Jakabova's hands, distanced himself from his rivals by a very easy 5 lengths.

Securing Jaroslav Linek's Leading Position

In the final test of the afternoon, 8-time and reigning jockey champion Jaroslav Linek demonstrated his experience, force, and rich knowledge. In the Shamal Sally Prize (Category IV, 2.400m, 2.300€), he achieved his 11th win of the current season on CHRISTERRA from the ELLIPSIS stable, setting himself up well for a ninth flat-racing champion title.

The race day also featured two divisions of the next round of the Slovak Pony League 2024. In the first, for smaller ponies. Nicole Veverkova with Hidalgo Li and Greta Csontos on GL Cronus had a beautiful battle for victory. In the end, the Hungarian representative was half a length ahead. The division for larger ponies (over 135 cm) was a clear win for Rakottyai, who remains Judit undefeated this season with her fifth consecutive victory. Emma Varsaniyova with Nuit Fleur finished second again, a length ahead of Patricia Pollakova on Sheron. Vanda Briskova with Kasper finished fourth.

God of War Wins the Demon Club Prize

The racing Saturday at Sluzeweic started explosively. In both of the hurdle races held at the beginning of the meeting, unexpected victories were achieved by horses from Kazimierz Rogowski's stable, with the Warsaw trainer even securing doubles in them. In the key flat race of the day, the Demon Club Prize, the favored God of War triumphed.

It was the first opportunity to compare three-year-olds with older horses over a 2.000m distance at Category I level. As expected, the only representative of the derby generation, **Juvenil**, led the race, taking advantage of the low weight – carrying only 50 kg under Karolina Kaminska. The rider gradually increased the pace. Behind **Juvenil** was **Freak Out**, and at the back, **God of War** was galloping. The whole group was tightly packed, and upon entering the straight, all the horses still had a chance to win.

Freak Out overtook Juvenil, and Ophelia's Aidan joined the fight with him. The rest of the horses tried to finish together; Quibou and Taymour briefly showed up in the race, but soon Ophelia's Aidan took the lead. It seemed he might win, but God of War, strongly

Kalysbek **Bolot** urged by Uulu. effectively accelerated on the outside and overtook the rival just before the finish line. Freak Out was third, and in the battle for fourth place, Juvenil narrowly defeated Quibou and Taymour. The small differences at the finish line suggest that weights could have played a significant role - God of War and Ophelia's Aidan carried 57 kg each, Freak Out 58 kg, Juvenil 50 kg, while Taymour, Quibou, and Senlis carried 60-61 kg.

God of War, owned by **Tomasz Rybicki**, is trained by **Maciej Janikowski**.

Magdalena Kierzkowska Triumphs on Inns of Spirit

Another race from the apprentice series gathered a large field at the start. Inns Of Spirit from Salih Plavac's stable and Sprytny Heniek ridden by Syimyk Urmatbek Uulu were the most favored. This pair, along with **Renoma**, galloped clearly at the head of the pack and already had an advantage over their rivals before entering the straight. Inns Spirit. urged by Magdalena Kierzkowska, was attacked by Sprytny Heniek, and Renoma fell to third place. However, Marsel Zholchubekov didn't give up on her. In the end, he attacked

once again and regained second place at the expense of the slightly weakening **Sprytny Heniek**. **Inns Of Spirit** won for the first time in his career for Salih Plavac's stable.

It is worth recalling that the stallion is a half-brother to the excellent Triple Crown winner **Bush Brave**. Syimyk Urmatbek Uulu retained the lead in the Young Riders' Championship thanks to his third-place finish on **Sprytny Heniek**, but he has only a one-point advantage over Marsel Zholchubekov.

The latter has already concluded his participation in the series (along with the third-ranked Erbol Zamudin Uulu), as after Saturday's win on **Invincible**Angel, he has 25 wins and has earned the title of apprentice jockey. For Magdalena Kierzkowska, it was the 9th win in her riding career, bringing her close to earning the title of senior apprentice.

Two Valuable Doubles for Kazimierz Rogowski's Stable

Saturday's hurdle races were incredibly dramatic. The day began with a race for three-year-olds for Major Henryk Dobrzanski "Hubal" Prize, with Boheme starting as the favorite. Only I Feel Good and Lips Achat were considered her main rivals for the win. Lips Achat, under Pawel Palczynski, set a strong pace and led for most of the distance with a certain advantage. I Feel Good, Boheme, and Dzersejka were a few lengths behind, while El Capri and Negocjacja trailed far behind.

With about 1.000m to go, **Boheme** began to chase **Lips Achat**, gradually closing the gap. Unfortunately, the mare made a mistake at the penultimate hurdle, stumbled, and Tereza Polesna

fell from the saddle. The race seemed decided. **Lips Achat** galloped with a significant lead, but he failed to clear the last jump. Moreover, when he got up, he collided with the finishing **I Feel Good**, resulting in Rostislav Bens' fall.

This left **Dzersejka** alone, with Anna Gozdzik avoiding trouble and heading for the biggest success of her career. Far behind her, **El Capri** and **Negocjacja** fought for second place. Unexpectedly, the mare proved better, marking a double for Kazimierz Rogowski's stable.

In the older horse hurdle race for Major Jerzy Sosnowski Prize, only four horses started. After Dubawi Warrior was withdrawn, **Anfield** was the big favorite. Rostislav Bens led on him ahead of **Negro Africa**, **Duszka**, and **The Residiencies**, who began to fall behind in the second half of the distance. The remaining three horses ran relatively close together, separated by 2-3 lengths each.

It seemed Anfield would pull away in the final stages, but he struggled with the last obstacle, allowing Duszka to overtake him. The mare galloped confidently under Tereza Polesna. maintaining her lead. Meanwhile, Negro Africa attacked the favorite upon entering the straight and unexpectedly finished second. Thus, the second double for Kazimierz Rogowski's Metis II stable became a fact!

Baden

Sunny and warm day in Baden near Vienna with around 3.000 spectators and over 150.000 euros wagered at the racetrack.

The star of the day was definitely **Gerhard Mayr**, who recorded five wins as a trainer and three as a driver.

The program opened with the seventh seasonal victory of Super Crowning, a 6-year-old mare (Orlando Vici-Supermind), whose mother Supermind was a former derby winner. The winning time was 17,30 over a distance of 2.100m.

33rd St. Leger

Seven participants, like in most previous generational races, saw the 4-year-old mare Mona Lisa Venus emerge as the driver winner with her Hubert Brandstatter in a time of 1.15.40 over a distance of 2.100m. She is the offspring of Light Kronos and Mon Amie Mic. From start to finish, she controlled the race and flawlessly performed the winning dance ahead of Muscle Magic with Krenmayr and Financial Times with Konlehner.

Mona Lisa Venus matched the race record with her time, which was set in 2010 and 2022 by Akkon and Lichtenworter, and Shining Star and Brandstatter.

Mayr's first win as a trainer was brought by his protege **Christoph Fuscher** with

Morley, an 8-year-old stallion (Istogramma Sas - Sunrise B), who celebrated just ahead of Mayr and Be Happy Now over 2.125m in a time of 18,50.

Next was the victory of Face Time Spada, the best 3-year-old filly ever in Austria and the absolute record holder of the 3-year-old generation, who returned with a win over 2.100m in a time of 18,70, absolutely dominant and secure ahead of second-placed El Pacco. Face Time Spada is the daughter of Prix De Amerique winner Face Time Bourbon and Spadaner, who is the daughter of Muscle Hill.

Next, Mayr and **Dorothy Br**, a 3-year-old filly **(Donato Hanover)**, recorded their second consecutive victory in a time of 17,30 over 1.600m, winning for the second time in ten days after an excellent victory in Germany.

Second and third were **Flashlight Cg** and **Rivoli**.

Then Kiwi's Rascal, a 10-year-old gelding (Cantab Hall - Power Kiwi), won start-to-finish for Gerhard Mayr's successor (granddaughter Steffi Mayr), currently the second-placed amateur driver in Austria overall and the absolute leader in the women's category, with a +40 win advantage over the next woman.

Kiwi trotted 16,00 over 1.600m ahead of **Atalante** and **Nadja Reisenbauer**, who will apparently have to hand over the women's champion driver's crown to the Mayr family successor!

Melody's Best Boy, a 3-year-old colt (Conway Hall - Kiwis' Melody), completed Mayr's driving hat-trick for the day with a victory over a distance of 2.100m, trotting 21,20, winning ahead of Donnas Gluck and Sharif Venus.

The main race of the day was the traditional Baden Mile. This was the 60th episode of this race, won by the filly Blind Date with driver Christoph Schwarz, recording a time of 1.13,50 over 1.609m, also convincingly and in a start-to-finish manner ahead of Edy Du Pommereux with Peter Untersteiner and Shining Star, followed by Invictus Mencourt. Blind had an easier task than expected as one of the two favorites, Maugli, galloped at the start.

The Baden Mile for amateur drivers was won by the 5-year-old mare **Delaware Wise As** and **Christoph Planitzer** in a time of 15,30, ahead of **Daria** and **Steffi Mayr**, and third-placed **Fabolous Cg Gruber**.

The longest race of the year at the Baden track, 3.100m, was won by Lawrence Boko (Zola Boko) and Gregor Krenmayr in a time of 17,30 ahead of Casino Royal with Fischer.

The next racing day is scheduled for August 4th.

Zaire Wise As sets a new Serbian record - 1.12.5

In the first of two runs of the most prestigious trotting race in Serbia, Zaire Wise As, a 9-year-old colt (Maharajah - Southwind Pamona), set a new Serbian record of 1.12,5. This stallion has been trotting excellently all season and confirmed his excellent form in the second run, where he was again the best, clocking a time of 1.14,4.
